

About the study

The results are based on Caliber's real-time tracking study that measures public perceptions of companies in the global energy sector on a daily basis.

The scores underpinning the ranking are based on the average responses to two questions presented on a 1-7 scale: to what extent do respondents trust and like each company.

The scores are then normalized into a 0-100 scale without any weighting or adjustments.

The 2023 global ranking of energy companies is based on 12,307 ratings of 130 of the most well-known energy companies across 13 markets (Brazil, China, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, Poland, Spain, Sweden, United Kingdom and United States).

The companies in the rankings are selected based on criteria such as yearly revenue, overall market share, size of customer base and belonging to a sub-industry of interest in the energy sector.

Some company scores are based on a small sample size (<100 respondents) due to a low public familiarity of the corresponding company.

In any study based on a population sample, there is a statistical margin of error in all measurements. In this study, the margin of error in the scores above is 1.6 points at a 95% confidence level.

This means that only differences in scores equal to or larger than 1.6 points can be regarded as statistically significant, though smaller changes may still indicate important tendencies.
